Music Notes

The first two stanzas of the song following today's sermon are in the first-person singular and lead us into a plural prayer for the gift of love. The final verse touches on the yearning for inward love. Our closing hymn tune is by English organist, Robert Jackson, and is a standard in North American hymnals. In both Hebrew and Greek, the words for "spirit" can equally be translated as "breath" or "wind." I will start this hymn with a very modest registration (the sounds, or pipes I use) and gradually build each verse tonally. The postludes this Sunday and next are both by my second favorite organ composer/arranger, Gilbert M. Martin. They feature our newly rebuilt reed pipes, the 8' and 4' trumpet and oboe ranks, augmented by two digital ranks, the 8' Willis trumpet, and the newest digital addition to the instrument, an 8' Krummhorn. The sounds are powerful and will, hopefully, conclude this morning's service in a tonally majestic manner.
