



Organ Notes

The hymn tune for this morning's Hymn of Response and the postlude is Darwall's 148th. The text was written by Charles Wesley in 1746, and the tune, by composer John Darwall, was first published as a setting for Psalm 148 in Aaron William's *New Universal Psalmodist* (1770) with only soprano and bass parts. The harmonization, however, dates from the 19th century. This jubilant tune wonderfully captures the mood of the text. The postlude is in three sections. It opens with the principal and mixture stops. The middle section is in another key and features our recently rebuilt and reinstalled 8' trumpet and 8' oboe reed pipes, yes, all 128 of them! The final section reverts to the original key and combines the registrations (stops used) from the first two sections.
