

Remembering the Forgotten God -Lead by Francis Chan

Today's church admires the gift of the Holy Spirit, but have we neglected to open it? Francis Chan is a senior pastor of Cornerstone Church in Simi Valley California. Chan tears away the wrapping paper and ribbons to uncover the source of the believing community's true power for witness and service. This 7-session DVD will prompt discussion and encourage application.





Music Notes

As the sole music staff member today, the music will trend toward the more "traditional." Our opening hymn has been a stalwart in this church for decades, but I can't remember the last time we sang it! So.... Our second hymn exemplifies an intense commitment to God, addressed as Love, Light, and Joy. It concludes with an invocation to those attributes through the Cross of Christ, which we will be revisiting during the sermon. The organ solo following the children's message is a setting of that same hymn by my favorite arranger, Alice Jordan. It starts introspectively and gradually builds to full organ incorporating Ms. Jordan's musical interpretation of the powerful text. Our final two hymns should also be well-known to this congregation, but ones we haven't regularly sung. As a suggestion, for further insight and clarity, you might read the texts ahead of time located in your chair hymnals. The texts parallel Pastor Billingsley's message to us this morning. The postlude is a joyous setting of the text Love Divine All Loves Excelling. However, the hymn tune used is not the same tune used in our hymnal for the hymn of the same title. The postlude tune which is used (Beecher) is set to hymn #343, Called As Partners in Christ's Service. This is yet another example of how poets and composers occasionally "fed off of one another."
